We're looking for a skilled, proactive individual who loves games to support the ongoing analysis of PikPok's titles to better understand user behaviour and commercial performance and drive an environment of effective decision-making based on sound hypotheses.

The Game Data Analyst's responsibilities include:

Responsibilities include, but are not necessarily limited to:

- 1. Partnering with product owners, marketers, designers, and others to ensure decisions are based on sound data analysis:
 - Gathering requirements from stakeholders, understanding their current goals, questions, and data needs.
 - Designing appropriate analyses and helping to define scope and expected timelines.
 - Delivering analysis reports, dashboards, and relevant documentation, and ensuring a shared understanding of any recommendations with stakeholders.
 - Promoting data-based decision making, educating stakeholders on analytical literacy and best practice, helping to avoid biases or other pitfalls.

- Ensuring relevant analytics data is used to improve strategic decision making and roadmap planning.
- 2. Providing analytics services for PikPok including but not limited to:
 - Analysing and presenting actionable data and insights into our titles; improving the acquisition, engagement, and monetization of our audiences.
 - Extract and analyze user data from multiple sources including server logs, 3rd party SDKs/tools, A/B tests etc.
 - Creating, maintaining, and distributing dashboards and insights to be used by decision makers around the business.
 - Assisting game developers to implement effective and efficient telemetry, A/B tests, etc.
 - Working with analytics developers and QA teams to assist in maintaining accurate, high-quality data and an efficient pipeline.
 - Learning new skills and technologies as necessary.
 - Following and contributing to analytics best practices and processes.

 - Participating actively as a member of the PikPok team.
 - Fostering open, two-way communications at all levels.
